Ashifa developed a small lump on her neck and was referred to a specialist for a biopsy. The results came back negative, but her general practitioner still recommended she get the lump removed as its structure was changing and her voice was being affected.

Ashifa's operation was successful but 10 days later, she received a call from her surgeon who informed her that the preliminary pathology results revealed she had an aggressive case of metastatic squamous head and neck cancer. "It made no sense to me, but they said in 25% of cases, they can't find the source of the cancer and they have to go in and zap everything," Ashifa explained. Unsettled, she underwent additional testing including a PET scan and an MRI. She also had a tonsillectomy, because the type of cancer she was diagnosed with has a tendency to hide in the tonsils, which must be removed in order to be biopsied. Ashifa described this procedure as the worst pain she has ever experienced.

Frustration set in and she decided to contact Best Doctors, to which she had access via her insurance policy.
